

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Writing

1. **Summarize** the movie
  - a) “The movie *The Butler* is about black Americans fight for their rights...”
  - b) “We get to see how Cecil...”
  - c) “In the end...”
2. Write a review - **what do you think** about the movie?
  - a) “The positive parts in the movie were... because”
  - b) “The negative parts were... because”

### Speaking

1. Screenshot your text – put it in imovie
2. Record your text – read it out loud
3. Find one or more pictures online – put it in imovie
4. Compare – record yourself talking freely about the similarities and differences between happenings in the movie and your life, and/or something else that you have read, heard or seen.

For example, you can talk about:

- a) racism
- b) making a change in different ways
- c) family relations

You should have *at least* **one picture**. Use CCSearch to find pictures (<http://search.creativecommons.org/>). Do not forget to name the source!

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### **Who is it for?**

*This is for kids your age* who do not know that much about American history. **For a higher grade** - Think about the listener! Think about what words you use, and the fact that they do not know that much about the movie or American history.

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
